A BYLAW RESPECTING ANIMAL CONTROL.


The Council of the Town of Big River in The Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. No person shall herd, graze or keep any horse, mule, donkey, sheep, goat, cattle, swine, rabbit, geese or poultry, nor shall any of the above animals be kept, herded or grazed at any time within the area bounded by Boundary road on the north, the south boundary of Town, and by 9th Avenue on the east to Cowan Lake on the west.
2. No person shall keep any horse, mule, donkey, sheep, goat, cattle, swine, rabbit, geese or poultry, at any time beyond the area designated in Section 1, without permission of Council.
3. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalties Bylaw of the Town.
4. Bylaw # 10/60 is hereby repealed.
