


**TOWN OF BIG RIVER  
BYLAW 2002 - 09**

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BIG RIVER TO REGULATE THE USE OF ALL  
TERRAIN VEHICLES**


1. In this Bylaw:
  - (a) "all terrain vehicle" means all terrain vehicle as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act
  - (b) "Crown Land" means Crown Land as defined in The Highway Traffic Act
  - (c) "highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act
  - (d) "private land" means land other than public land
  - (e) "public land" means public land as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act
  - (f) "vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in The Highway Traffic Act
2. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any private property within the corporate limits of the Town of Big River unless permission of the owner is obtained.
3. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any public property within the corporate limits of the Town of Big River.
4. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any Crown Land.
5. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on a highway except for the purpose of driving into or out of the town limits by the most direct and shortest route of travel available to him/her.
6. Bylaw 7/89 is hereby repealed.
