TOWN OF BIG RIVER

BYLAW NO 2011 - 02

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BIG RIVER TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS.

The Council of the Town of Big River, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Municipality" means the Town of Big River.
- 3. Section 5 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the Municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 4. No person shall provide a false or misleading statement to the Administrator, Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Peace Officer or any person appointed to enforce any Bylaw of the Municipality.
- 5. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of any offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a. In the case of an individual, to fine not less than \$100 and not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b. In the case of a corporation, to a fine not less than \$225 and not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
- 6. Bylaw 10/94 is hereby repealed.
