Recycle day is the 4th Tuesday of the month.

Your Blue Household Recycle Bin

Acceptable Recyclable Materials

- Paper and cardboard (please flatten cardboard)
- Newspaper, catalogues, and telephone books
- Shredded paper (separately bagged)
- Soup and beverage containers (please rinse out)
- Clean metal food cans (please rinse out)
- Aluminum foil and containers
- Plastics with the symbols from 1-7

***Please note: Plastic bags are once again permitted for recycling ***

<u>Materials not permitted</u> Do NOT put these items into your recycle bin

- Food contaminated paper or cardboard, cups, and plates
- Soiled tissues, napkins, and paper towels
- Oil, oil filters or products
- Liquids of any kind
- Propane tanks
- Ashes of any description
- Fuel or adhesives, combustibles, or hazardous waste
- Styrofoam or foam packaging
- Glass
- Scrap wire
- Outside plastics such as lawn chairs and kid's toys
- Automobile parts
- Yard waste (most landfills will accept yard waste and compost at no charge)
