# A BYLAW FOR PROVIDING FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES TO THE HAMLET OF DORE LAKE.

The Council of the RM of Big River No. 555, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The The Rural Municipality of Big River No. 555 is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Town of Big River and the Hamlet of Dore Lake, the terms of which are attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw and identified and marked Exhibit "A".

# EXHIBIT "A" BYLAW NO. 10/21

Memorandum of Agreement made this 13 day of 2021.

**BETWEEN:** 

THE TOWN OF BIG RIVER, a municipal corporation of and in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as the Town.

and

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BIG RIVER NO. 555, a municipal corporation of and in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as the R.M.,

and

THE HAMLET OF DORE LAKE, a municipal corporation of and in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as the Hamlet.

WHEREAS the parties to this agreement desire to establish the following:

1. MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BIG RIVER & DISTRICT FIRE DEPARTMENT AND THE HAMLET OF DORE LAKE.

WHEREAS, the Hamlet desires cooperation in providing assistance for emergency response services, where services required exceed the resources of the Hamlet; and

WHEREAS, this agreement is made so that The Big River & District Fire Department may provide fire protection services to the Hamlet upon their request if available; and

WHEREAS, fire or rescue services may be requested when the Hamlet is unable to respond with sufficient resources (manpower or equipment) to adequately deal with the incident; and

WHEREAS, all requests for the Big River & District Fire Department services shall be made through the 911 Emergency Communication Center by the Hamlet Fire Chief or designate; and

WHEREAS, when a request for services is received by The Big River & District Fire Department, the Fire Chief or designate, in their sole discretion, may dispatch such equipment, vehicles, and personnel as they deem necessary and only to the extent available, or none at all; and

WHEREAS, The Big River & District Fire Department will give priority to services required within their own jurisdiction and/or any contractual commitments; and

WHEREAS, the Incident Commander at the scene shall remain in charge of directing and control of the emergency response services provided by the responding agency; and

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WHEREAS the Hamlet agrees that all consumables or disposables used at any emergency shall be replaced or paid for by the Hamlet and the following rates will be billed to the Hamlet upon the dispatch of services:

Fire Truck E721S & E722S Utility Van U721S Water Tanker Truck T721S

Firefighter Hourly Rate

\$700.00/hr (each) \$200.00 (Flat Rate) \$200.00/hr

\$30.00/hr (each)

WHEREAS any party may withdraw from this Agreement by giving a minimum of 30 days notice in writing to the other parties; and

WHEREAS Authority to provide fire protection and Mutual Aid agreements are permitted under the following acts:

- **The Municipalities Act**, Division 7, Miscellaneous Powers, Section 42(1) providing services outside municipality
- The Northern Municipalities Act, 2010, Division 9 Miscellaneous Powers, Section 63 providing services outside municipality
- Emergency Planning Act, Mutual Aid areas-Section 11(2).

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree to the terms, conditions, and agreements contained within this document.

This agreement shall come into force upon approval of all parties.
