



Council Bursary



The Town and R.M. of Big River No. 555 are providing two \$1,000.00 bursaries to support eligible individuals. **Bursary No.1** is for students attending Post Secondary school and **Bursary No.2** is for students who plan to pursue careers in skilled trades and apprenticeships.

Qualifications:

Bursary No. 1 – Post Secondary

- Between the ages of 17 to 21
- Must be planning to attend post-secondary school in the fall of 2025
- Applicant must be a graduating student from Big River Public High School in 2025
- **Note:** Bursary funds will be disbursed after successful completion of the first year of post-secondary studies

Bursary No. 2 – Trades and Apprenticeship

- Between the ages of 17 to 21
- Must be pursuing a career in a skilled trade
- Applicant must be a graduating student from Big River Public High School in 2025
- **Note:** Bursary funds will be disbursed upon successful completion of the first year of an approved apprenticeship program

2. autobiography in report form (report requirements listed below);
3. attach one letter of reference (requirements are listed below); and
4. supply a current picture.

Report Requirements:

Submit one typed autobiography on white 8.5" x 11" paper. The autobiography report should be clearly written in acceptable English and be free of errors in spelling, grammar, and punctuation. It should include, but is not limited to, education and career information, extracurricular involvement, and any additional information that you feel will prove helpful. The Selection Committee will judge the reports according to the content and will select individuals to interview before awarding the bursary.

Letter of Reference:

Your Letter of Reference can be provided from a variety of people such as a School Principal, Teacher, or community leader. Please do not submit letters of reference from a parent, guardian, or relative.

Deadline:

Completed applications and attachments must be received on or before 4 p.m., Friday, June 6, 2025.
